TOURNAMENTS - USSA

Maties Men & Women took part in the annual USSA tournament from 04 - 08 July in CPT.

Maties women played NWU, UJ & UCT in their pool. Results after round robin: 1-1 vs NWU, 3-0 vs UJ & 8-0 vs UCT to finish 1st in their pool. Maties Men played Tuks, Varsity College & NMMU in their pool. Results after round robin: 2-4 Tuks, 9-0 VC, 4-1 NMMU to finish 2nd in their pool.

Double Maties vs Wits semi-final on Thursday 07 July. Our teams stepped off the turf as finalists of the USSA tournament after the women beat WITS 3-2 & the men beat WITS 2-0.

Friday 08 July finals day. The first time since 2009 where we could win a double gold. Another double final day as both teams played old rivals TUKS.

Chukka 1 of the women's match saw shots on goal but nothing that separates the two teams. Six minutes into the 2nd chukka Kayla Swarts scored the first goal of the match. 13-minutes later Tuks scored the equalizer. With only 4-minutes on the clock Caylin Maree deflected Maties 2nd & final goal to secure the win & gold medal for the women (Last USSA final the women won was in 2014).

After securing our first gold, the men were on next in a big game as they lost against Tuks in the pool stage. Tuks opened the scoring with just 3-min on the clock. Maties responded at the end of the 1st chukka with two dragflick goals from Jacques van Tonder. Another last minute goal in the 2nd chukka from Jacques, put Maties in a comfortable 3-1 lead. The 3rd chukka started with a bang when Maties player Rohniel scored their 4th goal giving them a 3-goal lead. Within 10minutes Tuks brought the heat and scored two goals to get back within one goal. It wasn't until the 56th minute when Kenton Mellville scored the 5th goal and with that securing the Maties men's gold medal match for 2022. The last time the men won USSA was in 2016.

With two golds in our name we also received the player of the tournament awards. Congratulations to Stephanie Botha & Jacques van Tonder on receiving the respective wards.
