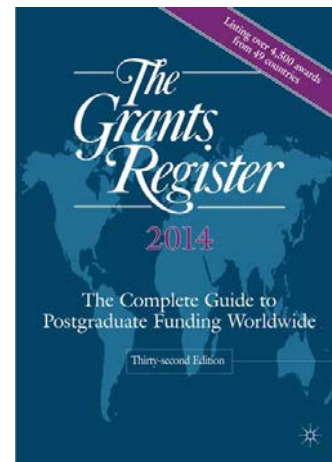

AC21 Special Project Fund

The AC21 Special Project Fund (SPF) was created in order to promote the development of research and educational exchange between AC21 members by financially supporting a variety of activities and research projects. Events can include mini-symposia, mini-workshops, schooling projects, start-up funds for long term research projects, or small international forums, as well as traditional research proposals that attempt to include as wide a circle of contacts and participants as possible. Applicants must be academic staff members of an AC21 member institution who hold faculty positions.

DST-NRF Centre of Excellence in Human Development

The CoE in Human Development is offering bursaries to post-doctoral fellows, and doctoral and master's students who wish to do research in human development. The amount of the bursaries are R70 000 per annum for two (2) years and R100 000 per annum for three(3) years, for master's and doctoral students respectively, and R200 000 per annum for post-doctoral fellows for three(3) years. Universities and Science Councils may top-up bursaries in accordance with their institutional policies. *Bursaries are available for full-time students only.*
