CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

This **building is going to be connected** to the new greywater system to take **toilet flushing 'off the grid'**.

Stellenbosch University has partnered with professionals to develop and implement a sustainable campus water strategy to optimize use and become more resilient to climatic shocks, such as droughts.

As part of this plan, efficient fixtures (showerheads, taps, toilets, etc.) were installed in all campus buildings, achieving a 50% campus-wide saving during the drought.

The next step involves implementing a **campus greywater system** – one of the largest in Africa. Shower greywater will be isolated, collected for treatment and sterilisation at a centralised plant and finally stored for toilet flushing and irrigation.
